

## ‘going to’ and ‘will’ pelmanism cards (pre-intermediate)

1. Print and cut up the cards, 1 set per group of 3-5 students.
2. Students spread the cards face down on a desk, and sit round the desk.
3. They take turns to turn over 2 cards, reading the sentences, until they find a pair.
4. When they find a pair, they score 1 point and keep the cards.
5. After the pelmanism game, each student reads out the problem cards that they won and the first one to remember the response scores a point.
6. The student with the most points at the end wins!

**Note:** the writing is in grey so that it doesn't show through the paper when the cards are face down on the desk.

Why aren't you ready?	<i>The taxi's going to be here in 10 minutes.</i>	Are you ready to order sir?	<i>Yes. I think I'll have the salmon.</i>
What are your plans for this evening?	<i>I'm tired. I'm just going to watch TV.</i>	Is dinner ready yet?	<i>Nearly. I'll let you know when it's cooked.</i>
